

The **Equality Act 2010** provides women with important protections on the basis of **SEX** and it's entirely lawful to exclude men - regardless of their 'gender identity'- in order to ensure women's privacy, dignity, safety and fairness.

This applies to areas where women are undressing, sleeping, accessing health & personal care services, hospital wards, refuges, prisons, and sports.

Yet many organisations have already chosen to implement 'self-ID' policies that allow men to self-identify as women and enter women-only spaces.

They have been badly advised about the law and are **WRONG!**

**EDUCATE** women so they know their rights. Share this leaflet and talk to your friends and colleagues so that they know women-only spaces and services are protected by law.

**CHALLENGE** service providers and public bodies if you object to situations where women-only spaces and services are not being upheld.

**ASK** your MP and MSPs to reject the proposed reforms to the Gender Recognition Act, and call for clear guidance on the use of single-sex exceptions in the Equality Act.
