GENDER RECOGNITION REFORM

WHAT IS THE BILL?

The Scottish Government has drafted the Gender Recognition Reform Bill which will allow anyone, from the age of 16, to change the sex on their birth certificate.

WHAT WILL IT MEAN?

'Woman' and 'man' will no longer have a biological meaning in law and this will destroy many of the rights that we take for granted.

These rights - like the right to single-sex services - exist to ensure privacy, dignity, fairness and safety, especially for women and girls.

WHY DOES IT MATTER?

If the Bill becomes law it could be exploited by predatory men who want to harm women and girls. We need to stop this happening. We need to stop this assault on our rights.

WHAT CAN I DO?
