The Scottish Government does.

And they want to make it law by amending the Gender Recognition Act.

CURRENT LAW:

Gender Recognition Act 2004

- Applicants must have diagnosis of gender dysphoria
- Age 18 or over
- 2 years experience of living in new gender role

PROPOSED CHANGES:

Gender Recognition Reform Bill

- Removes diagnosis, so anyone can declare to be the opposite sex
- Lowers age to 16
- 3 months living in role + 3 months wait after applying

We are campaigning to **STOP** the Gender Recognition Reform Bill from becoming law.

- ✓ The current legislation is fully compliant with EU and international law.
- ✗ Opening up Gender Recognition Certificates beyond the tiny number of people who have a medical diagnosis is reckless and harmful to women's rights.
- ✗ The Scottish Government will deem **any** man to be a woman at his request, even when the NHS say he is not eligible for hormones or surgery to change his appearance.
- ✗ The Government and many public bodies have already introduced policies encouraging such men into women's and girls' toilets, changing rooms, hospital wards, refuges, prisons and sports.
