

MAKE THE EQUALITY ACT CLEAR



The Equality Act 2010 covers nine separate protected characteristics, including “Sex” and “Gender Reassignment”. This protects people against sex discrimination as well as protecting trans people against discrimination.

There has been much confusion about how the Equality Act and the Gender Recognition Act interact. This has caused uncertainty and conflict for women, transgender people, and service providers.

This petition calls on the Government to update the Equality Act 2010 to **make it clear that the protected characteristic of “sex” means biological sex**, and is not modified by the holding of a Gender Recognition Certificate.
