Say **NO** to the Gender Recognition Reform Bill

The Scottish Government is trying to pass legislation for Gender Recognition Certificates which removes any medical diagnosis, lowers the minimum age to 16, and reduces the time lived in the 'acquired gender' to 3 months.

- × The public do not want this law change.
 - Almost every independent poll shows 70-80% against this reform, with the vast majority in every political party against it. The Equality watchdog and United Nations are critical.
- The Govt will deem ANY man to be a woman at his request. The SNP and Greens voted against an amendment to prevent sex offenders obtaining a GRC.
- Women and girls single-sex spaces cannot be protected. The Govt believes a man with a GRC is entitled to full access to all of women's and girls spaces: hospital wards, refuges, sports, prisons, toilets and changing rooms, plus jobs reserved for women such as rape counsellers & breast screening examiners.
- Medical evidence for children has been ignored. The Govt will confirm a 16 year old as the opposite sex, disregarding evidence that most teens do not have a fixed identity, and it can lock a child into a pathway of harmful and irreversible medical and surgical procedures.
