We are delighted to confirm funding for 1 April 2026 to 31 March 2028 as detailed below:

Total funded amount: £1,468,914.00

- 2026-27 – DES Year 5: £734,457.00
- 2027-28 – DES Year 6: £734,457.00

Please note that the 2027-28 award is indicative only at this stage and is subject to annual Parliamentary approval of the Scottish budget.

The following is a summary of the service/activity which funding will contribute to:

Glasgow and Clyde Rape Crisis Centre provides emotional and therapeutic support and advocacy in both justice and welfare environments, to women and girls who have been affected by gender-based violence, across Glasgow, Renfrewshire, East Renfrewshire, West Dunbartonshire, East Dunbartonshire, and Inverclyde. They provide 1:1 support and long term advocacy for women and girls from an ethnic minority background and those involved in the criminal justice process.

DES funding will support direct and indirect staff costs and contribution toward organisational overheads and running costs.

Your organisation will be working towards the following outcomes:

- GCRC maximises the safety and wellbeing of women and girls.

- GCRC ensures that women and girls voices are heard and their rights respected.
- GCRC ensures BAME women and girls have equal access to integrated services and the criminal justice system.
