Delivering Equally Safe – multi-year funding award

We are delighted to confirm funding for 1 April 2026 to 31 March 2028 as detailed below:

Total funded amount: £63,940.00

- 2026-27 – DES Year 5: £31,970.00
- 2027-28 – DES Year 6: £31,970.00

Please note that the 2027-28 award is indicative only at this stage and is subject to annual Parliamentary approval of the Scottish budget.

The following is a summary of the service/activity which funding will contribute to:

DES funding will support The Young Women's Movement (YWM) to bring together groups of young women to aid their understanding and advocate for their rights on the topics of healthy relationships, consent, online safety and digital/AI enabled violence

Your organisation will be working towards the following outcomes:

- Young women have increased opportunities to co-design the development of national prevention responses to digital and AI-enabled forms of violence against girls and women. YWM will work with young women to continue to amplify and build on the existing Young Women Know resources and Young Women Lead AI work.
- Participants increase their confidence, knowledge and awareness of digital and AI-enabled harms. They will report increased understanding of their rights in relation to digital and AI-enabled harms, confidence in advocating for their rights and will know where they can access support.
- Participants have opportunities to lead an awareness raising campaign and influencing activity relating to consent, online safety and digital/AI enabled violence. Participants influencing activity will increase decision/policy makers awareness of issues relating to consent, online safety and digital/AI enabled violence.
- Outputs will support young people, decision-makers and communities across Scotland to have increased understanding of

digital rights, consent and the prevention of digital and AI-enabled harms.
