To increase women+'s awareness of their human rights by recognising their lived experiences as a catalyst for social change. To increase their participation and engagement in human rights awareness-raising through a variety of accessible activities with our community, wider networks, and stakeholders. To offer one-to-one support and informal advocacy. To foster participation and leadership opportunities for women+ to influence initiatives that reflect their experiences and contribute to meaningful change. To ensure inclusion and representation in the project, particularly among those with intersectional protected characteristics. To continue developing anti-racism work with the community and wider networks.

Your organisation will be working towards the following:

Lived Experience and Human Rights Awareness – Exploring how women+ can use their personal experiences to understand and advocate for their rights.

Co-Production and Community Development– Delivering training for women+ to actively shape and co-develop accessible activities with our community and networks, ensuring human rights awareness-raising is informed by lived experiences.

Intersectionality and Inclusive Representation – Ensuring involvement of diverse voices, particularly those with multiple protected characteristics in the overall project.

Anti-Racism and Social Justice Action – Continuing to develop and embed anti-racism work within the community and wider networks. As well as promoting inclusive practices through community-led initiatives.

One-to-One Support and Informal Advocacy – Providing tailored support to women+, ensuring they can navigate and assert their rights.
